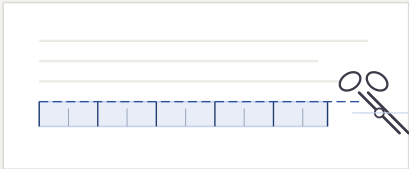


How to use the *ruler*

PRINT AT 100% · DO NOT SCALE TO FIT PAGE

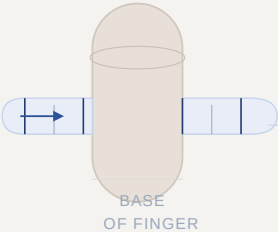


CUT ALONG THE STRIP

CUT THE RULER STRIP

Print the page at 100% scale — never "fit to page." Cut along the printed ruler strip. The strip should be roughly 10mm wide.

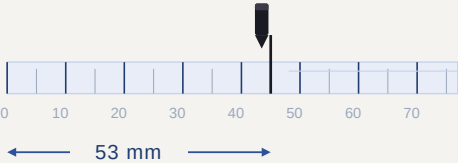
WRAP SNUGLY AROUND FINGER

BASE OF FINGER

WRAP AROUND THE FINGER BASE

Wrap the strip around the base of the finger you intend to wear the ring on — not the knuckle. Keep it snug but comfortable. You should be able to move the strip without it sliding freely.

MARK WHERE ENDS MEET

53 mm

MARK AND MEASURE

Where the strip overlaps itself, make a small pen mark. Lay the strip flat and read the measurement at that mark — this is your finger circumference in mm.

FIND YOUR DIAMETER

Take your circumference measurement and find it in the **Circ. mm** column of the size chart. Read across to the **Ø mm** column — that is your ring size to order.

RULER — PRINT AT 100% SCALE
